

#### Awareness, Fundraising and Community Partnerships

In 2024 we held 2 awareness events with 182 people in attendance.

We were hosted at 7 community events.

We drew attention to the social issue of human sex trafficking through signs on a busy street in town during the month of January. Our CEO and 1 board member were guests on a local radio station in March.

We held 3 successful fundraising events.

As part of our partnership with Fierce Love 4 Good our 20 volunteers packed 225 Angel Packs and gave them to local victim service agencies.

### The Well House Update

#### Update

We projected a \$180k budget for renovations and we have already raised over 160K towards that goal. The house is 75% complete. We estimate that it should be finished by the end of May 2025.

The Well House will home up to 3 adult biological females, 18+, who are beginning their process of recovering from the trauma of sexual exploitation and abuse. Upon completing their 4-6 week stay, we will transition them to a long term restorative care home that best suits their individual needs.
